



The graph shows the number of people with each score (percentage correct out of 34 questions) on Midterm 1. The vertical red lines and red numbers show the (approximate) breakdown of course grades that would correspond to the scores on the midterm, if I had to issue those grades right now, except they do not take any extra-credit clicker points into account. Your final course grade will be based on averaging together the percent you get correct on each test, *NOT* on an average involving your 1.0-4.0 grade on each test.

These grades are just a rough estimate at this point, to give you some idea of how you are doing relative to the other students. If you are just above a cutoff, you should continue working hard to stay there. If you are just below a cutoff, working hard will easily move you up a notch.

If you got less than 50% correct on this exam, you will need to work hard to be sure of getting even a 1.0 in the course.
